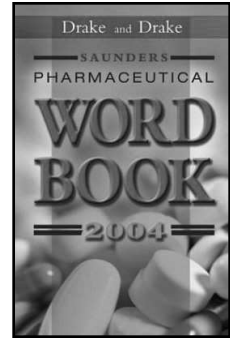

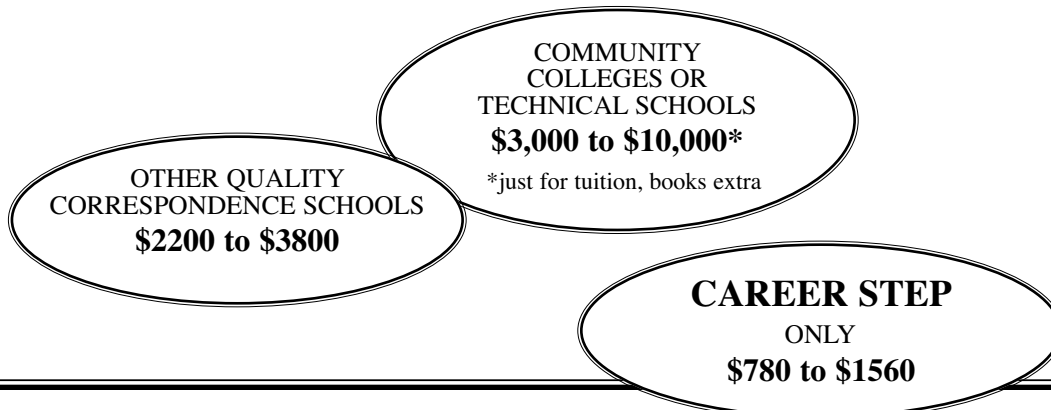

Most at-home MTs earn wages according to productivity. The more they type, the more they make. According to The 2004-05 Occupational Outlook Handbook published by the United States Department of Labor, the number of medical transcriptionists needed in the United States is expected to **grow** by 30.3% during the period 2000 to 2012. This represents an increase of approximately 30,603 available jobs for medical transcriptionists.

50% earn between \$28,397 and \$33,484 annually
25% earn more than \$33,484 per year
