What do phlebotomy technicians do?

Within the large and growing healthcare industry, phlebotomy technicians play a key role in keeping a healthcare facility running smoothly. They draw blood for tests or transfusions, for blood donations, or even for research. Their duties frequently include the following:

- Draw blood from patients and blood donors
- Calm patients' fears about the blood draw
- Verify identity to ensure proper labeling of the blood
- Label the drawn blood for testing or processing
- Enter patient information into a computer system
- Assemble and maintain medical instruments such as needles, test tubes, and blood vials

Where do phlebotomy technicians work?

Phlebotomy technicians work in healthcare facilities such as hospitals, medical and diagnostic laboratories, blood donor centers, and physicians' offices. The 24/7 nature of healthcare makes night and weekend schedules a possibility; however, most phlebotomy technicians work standard daytime hours.

How much do phlebotomy technicians earn?

With opportunities nationwide, phlebotomy technicians can earn competitive salaries. The U.S. Department of Labor reports that the middle 50% of professionals in the field earn \$33,670.*

Is the phlebotomy technician field growing?

The healthcare industry is growing rapidly due to the country's aging population and new healthcare laws. As medical practices expand, medical assistants will take on more routine duties so physicians can see more patients. Employment for medical assistants is expected to grow by 25%, or over 30,000 jobs, by 2026.*
